Job Aid: Steps for Best Practice Garbing for Entry to the HD Buffer Room with the sink on the clean side of anteroom

Before entering anteroom

Dirty Side anteroom



- 1. Change into scrubs and facility-dedicated shoes.
- 2. Use restroom; remove makeup, jewelry, and extra clothing; tie up hair.
- 3. Clean personal glasses with EPA-registered one-step bactericidal disinfectant cleaner wipe on frames and lens cleaner on lenses; enter the anteroom.






- 4. Don a face mask with folds down on outside; bend nose bar; pull down under chin, no gaps; beard cover over mask if goatee.
- Don the head cover (bouffant cap) over ears and also a hood if full beard, hijab, or other headdress, or hair is not contained by bouffant cap.
- 6. Don 2 pairs of shoe covers on each foot, one foot at a time crossing over the LOD. Ensure at least outer shoe cover is waterproof and seamless.





- Perform hand hygiene, including a 30-second lather to the elbows after using nail pick on wet, lathered hands.
- 8. Dry hands with low-lint wipes.
- 9. Don a non-HD gown; then don an HD gown over the non-HD gown. Do not put thumb loops in place. Pull the sleeves of the HD gown up to mid-forearm. Enter the buffer room.



- 11. Apply alcohol-based hand rub to nails, hands, and wrists.
- 12. When hands are dry, put the non-HD gown's thumb loops in place and don the 1st pair of gloves, ensuring the cuffs of this pair are placed over the nonhazardous gown's sleeve.
- 13. Use the sterile paper from the 1st pair of gloves to pull the HD gown sleeves down over the cuffs of the 1st pair of gloves without contaminating the gloves.
- 14. Don the 2nd pair of gloves (cuffs over HD gown sleeves)
- 15. Sanitize gloves with sIPA unless an initial GFT sampling is being performed.
